You will have a chance of winning a prize if you can accurately answer all of the question on the CantaloupeCache sheet and return it to the 4-H Technology Team's exhibit in the Multi-Purpose Building.

1. Return this Entry Form to the University of Nevada-Reno Cooperative Extension Office by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2007 and receive one free admission pass to get into the Cantaloupe Festival on any day of the festival.
